~BETH-EMEK (19) (Beth-e'mek) [House of the Low Plain]

- A town in the territory of the tribe of Asher.
- Then the fifth lot came out for the tribe of the sons of Asher by their families. (Joshua 19:24)
- And it went back toward the rising of the sun to Beth-dagon and reached to Zebulun and the valley of Iphtah-el to the north, to Beth-emek and Neiel, and it went out to Cabul on the left. (Joshua 19:27)
- It is presently identified with Tell Mimas, Tel Bet Ha`Emeq, about 8 kilometers (5 miles) Northeast of Acco. The original name appears to be reflected in that of the nearby Arab village of `Amqa now abandoned.
