~BETH-PELET (22) (Beth-pel'et) [House of Escape]

- A town in the southern part of Judah's inheritance.
- And the cities at the extremity of the tribe of the sons of Judah toward the boundary of Edom in the south came to be Kabzeel and Eder and Jagur. (Joshua 15:21)
- And Hazar-gaddah and Heshmon and Beth-pelet. (Joshua 15:27)
- It was among the Judean cities reoccupied after the Babylonian exile.
- And in Jeshua and in Moladah and in Beth-pelet. (Nehemiah 11:26)
- The other towns listed with it indicate a location in the vicinity of Beer-sheba, but the identification is uncertain.
