

**~BETH-SHEMITE (22)**

**(Beth-she'mite) [Of, or Belonging to Beth-shemesh]**

- An inhabitant of **Beth-shemesh** of Judah. The term is applied to Joshua, the owner of the field where the ark of the covenant rested on a large stone, exposed to view, after being taken there on a Philistine wagon.
- And the wagon itself came into the field of Joshua the **Beth-shemite** and kept standing there, where there was a large stone. And they went splitting up the wood of the wagon, and the cows they offered up as a burnt offering to Yehowah. (**1 Samuel 6:14**)
- And the golden jebels were to the number of all the cities of the Philistines belonging to the five axis lords, from the fortified city to the village of the open country. And the great stone upon which they rested the ark of Yehowah is a witness down to this day in the field of Joshua the **Beth-shemite**. (**1 Samuel 6:18**)
