

**~BETHUEL 1 (55)**  
**(Be-thu'el)**

- **Abraham's nephew, born to his brother Nahor by Milcah.**
- **Now it came about after these things that the report got through to Abraham. Here Milcah herself has also borne sons to Nahor your brother. (Genesis 22:20)**
- **And Chesed and Hazo and Pildash and Jidlaph and Bethuel. (Genesis 22:22)**
- **Bethuel became father to Rebekah and Laban.**
- **And Bethuel became the father of Rebekah. These eight Milcah bore to Nahor the brother of Abraham. (Genesis 22:23)**
- **Well, it came about that before he had finished speaking, why, here coming out was Rebekah, who had been born to Bethuel the son of Milcah the wife of Nahor, Abraham's brother, and her water jar was upon her shoulder. (Genesis 24:15)**
- **At that she said to him; I am the daughter of Bethuel the son of Milcah, whom she bore to Nahor. (Genesis 24:24)**
- **Now Rebekah had a brother and his name was Laban. So Laban went running to the man who was outside at the fountain. (Genesis 24:29)**
- **He later acknowledged the divine direction that brought Abraham's slave to his home in search of a wife for Isaac, saying; along with Laban, From Yehowah this thing has issued.**
- **Then Laban and Bethuel answered and said; From Yehowah this thing has issued. We are unable to speak bad or good to you. (Genesis 24:50)**
- **He is called a Syrian or an Aramaean, dwelling in the flatland of Aram.**
- **And Isaac happened to be forty years old at his taking Rebekah the daughter of Bethuel the Syrian of Paddanaram, the sister of**

Laban the Syrian, as his wife. (**Genesis 25:20**)

- Get up, go to Paddanaram to the house of **Bethuel** the father of your mother and from there take yourself a wife from the daughters of Laban the brother of your mother. (**Genesis 28:2**)
- So Isaac sent Jacob away, and he struck out for Paddanaram, for Laban the son of **Bethuel** the Syrian, the brother of Rebekah, mother of Jacob and Esau. (**Genesis 28:5**)
