~BETONIM (27) (Bet'o-nim) [Pistachio Nuts]

- A city East of the Jordan that Moses gave as a gift to the tribe of Gad.
- Furthermore, Moses made a gift to the tribe of Gad, the sons of Gad by their families. (Joshua 13:24)
- And their territory came to be Jazer and all the cities of Gilead and half of the land of the sons of Ammon as far as Aroer, which is in front of Rabbah. (Joshua 13:25)
- And from Heshbon to Ramath-mizpeh and Betonim and from Mahanaim to the border of Debir. (Joshua 13:26)
- And in the low plain Beth-haram and Beth-nimrah and Succoth and Zaphon, the rest of the royal realm of Sihon the king of Heshbon, the Jordan being the border as far as the extremity of the sea of Chinnereth on the side of Jordan toward the east. (Joshua 13:27)
- Betonim is generally held to be the present-day Khirbet Batneh in the mountainous country 21 kilometers (13 miles) West of Rabbah in Ammon.
