~BIGVAI 1 (34) (Big'vai)

- Forefather of some 2,000 sons of Bigvai who returned to Jerusalem with Zerubbabel in 537 B.C.E.
- And these were the sons of the jurisdictional district that went up out of the captivity of the exiled people whom Nebuchadnezzar the king of Babylon had taken into exile at Babylon and who later returned to Jerusalem and Judah, each one to his own city. (Ezra 2:1)
- Those who came with Zerubbabel, Jeshua, Nehemiah, Seraiah, Reelaiah, Mordecai, Bilshan, Mispar, Bigvai, Rehum, Baanah. The number of the men of the people of Israel. (Ezra 2:2)
- The sons of Bigvai, two thousand and fifty-six. (Ezra 2:14)
- The sons of Bigvai, two thousand and sixty-seven. (Nehemiah 7:19)
- Later, in 468 B.C.E, more of his descendants made the trip with Ezra.
- Now these were the heads of their paternal houses and the genealogical enrollment of those going up with me during the reign of Artaxerxes the king out of Babylon. (Ezra 8:1)
- And of the sons of Bigvai, Uthai and Zabbud, and with them seventy males. (Ezra 8:14)
