One of the Levitical sons of Henadad. Possibly the forefather of one who concurred in the trustworthy arrangement in the days of Nehemiah, in which case he could be the same as;

- So in view of all this we are contracting a trustworthy arrangement, both in writing and attested by the seal of our princes, our Levites and our priests. (Nehemiah 9:38)
- Now attesting it by seal there were, Nehemiah the Tirshatha, the son of Hacaliah, and Zedekiah. (Nehemiah 10:1)
- Also the Levites, Jeshua the son of Azaniah, Binnui of the sons of Henadad, Kadmiel (Nehemiah 10:9)
- If, on the other hand, Binnui himself sealed this agreement, instead of one of his descendants, he could have been the same as or he may have simply been another person with that name.
