## ~BOHAN 2 (19) (Bo'han) [possibly, Thumb]

- The stone of Bohan served as a boundary marker for the tribes of Benjamin and Judah.
- And the boundary went up to Beth-hoglah and passed over at the north of Beth-arabah, and the boundary went up to the stone of Bohan the son of Reuben. (Joshua 15:6)
- And it was marked out northward and went out to En-shemesh and went out to Geliloth, which is in front of the ascent of Adummim, and it went down to the stone of Bohan the son of Reuben. (Joshua 18:17)
- It lay near the Northwest corner of the Salt Sea and evidently toward the foot of the plateau-like Low Plain of Achor.
