[English, bravely, courageously, daringly, intrepidly, audaciously, gallantly, fearlessly, unflinchingly]

- Once converted to Christianity Paul spoke **boldly** in Damascus about the Way.
- So Barnabas came to his aid and led him to the apostles, and he told them in detail how on the road he had seen the Lord and that he had spoken to him, and how in Damascus he had spoken **boldly** in the name of Jesus. ([Acts of Apostles 9:27](#))
- And he continued with them, walking in and out at Jerusalem, speaking **boldly** in the name of the Lord. ([Acts of Apostles 9:28](#))
- Apollos spoke **boldly** but he needed more accurate knowledge to speak truthfully and in full accord with known truth.
- And this man started to speak **boldly** in the synagogue. When Priscilla and Aquila heard him, they took him into their company and expounded the way of God more correctly to him. ([Acts of Apostles 18:26](#))
