

~BORASHAN (23)

(Bor'a-shan) [possibly, Pit of Smoke]

- One of the places that David and his men frequented during his time as a fugitive.
- And to those in Hormah, and to those in **Borashan**, and to those in Athach. (**1 Samuel 30:30**)
- And to those in Hebron, and to all the places where David had walked about, he and his men. (**1 Samuel 30:31**)
- Some scholars consider it to be the same as **Ashan**.
- Ain, Rimmon and Ether and **Ashan**, four cities and their settlements. (**Joshua 19:7**)
- A Simeonite enclave city in the southern part of Judah's territory, a short distance Northwest of Beer-sheba.
