[English, boasts, blows own horn, crows, shows off, sings own praises, swanks, talks big]

- James shows how out of proportion to its ability to accomplish the tongue is. It is like a small fire started in a great woodland setting it all afire. Bragging causes matters also to get out of hand and it is often the beginning of wicked acts.
- So, too, the tongue is a little member and yet makes great brags. Look! How little a fire it takes to set so great a woodland on fire! (James 3:5)
- But now you take pride in your self-assuming brags. All such taking of pride is wicked. (James 4:16)
