

~BRAG (38)

[English, boast, blow your own horn, crow, show off, sing your own praises, swank, talk big]

- Yehowah counseled Gideon that he had too many men to go up against Midian and that if he used all his force then he might **brag** that he and his men had brought about the victory.
- Yehowah now said to Gideon; The people who are with you are too many for me to give Midian into their hand. Perhaps Israel would **brag** about itself against me, saying; My hand it was that saved me. (Judges 7:2)
- Yehowah counsel his people not to **brag** about their wealth, power or wisdom, but the **brag** that they know Yehowah.
- This is what Yehowah has said; Let not the wise man **brag** about himself because of his wisdom, and let not the mighty man **brag** about himself because of his mightiness. Let not the rich man **brag** about himself because of his riches. (Jeremiah 9:23)
- But let the one **bragging** about himself brag about himself because of this very thing, the having of insight and the having of knowledge of me, that I am Yehowah, the One exercising loving-kindness, justice and righteousness in the earth, for in these things I do take delight, is the utterance of Yehowah. (Jeremiah 9:24)
- The low plains were the productive part of the land where her wealth of agricultural produce was found. Yehowah counseled them not to trust in it by **bragging** about their wealth.
- Why do you **brag** about the low plains, your flowing low plain, O daughter unfaithful, you the one trusting in her treasures, saying; Who will come to me? (Jeremiah 49:4)
