~BREASTBAND (25)

- A sash or girdle worn by a bride on her wedding day. It marked her status as a married woman. Yehowah as a husband to Israel illustrates the sin and extreme disregard of Israel toward him, saying;
- Israel's God should have been her greatest ornament, but she had forsaken him for other gods.
- Can a virgin forget her ornaments, a bride her breastbands? And yet my own people, they have forgotten me days without number. (Jeremiah 2:32)
- The headdresses and the step chains and the breastbands and the houses of the soul and the ornamental humming shells. (Isaiah 3:20)
- Raise your eyes all around and see. They have all of them been collected together. They have come to you. As I am living, is the utterance of Yehowah, with all of them you will clothe yourself just as with ornaments, and you will bind them on yourself like a bride. (Isaiah 49:18)
