~BUKKIAH (31)

(Buk-ki'ah) [from a root meaning flask]

- Son of Heman of the tribe of Levi. Bukkiah was chosen by lot to head the 6th of 24 musician groups that David organized for service at Yehowah's sanctuary. He and his sons and brothers assisting him totaled 12
- Further, David and the chiefs of the service groups separated for the service some of the sons of Asaph, Heman and Jeduthun the one's prophesying with the harps, with the stringed instruments and with the cymbals. And from their number the official men for their service came to be. (1 Chronicles 25:1)
- Of Heman: the sons of Heman, Bukkiah, Mattaniah, Uzziel, Shebuel and Jerimoth, Hananiah, Hanani, Eliathah, Giddalti and Romamti-ezer, Joshbekashah, Mallothi, Hothir, Mahazioth. (1 Chronicles 25:4)
- And the lot proceeded to come out: the first belonging to Asaph for Joseph, for Gedaliah the second, he and his brothers and his sons were twelve. (1 Chronicles 25:9)
- The sixth for Bukkiah, his sons and his brothers, twelve. (1 Chronicles 25:13)
- For the twenty-fourth, for Romamti-ezer, his sons and his brothers, twelve. (1 Chronicles 25:31)
