- However, the princes of the sons of Ammon said to Hanun their Lord; Is David honoring your father in your eyes in that he has sent to you comforters? Is it not for the sake of searching through the city and to spy it out and to overthrow it that David has sent his servants to you? (2 Samuel 10:3)
- However, the princes of the sons of Ammon said to Hanun, Is David honoring your father in your eyes in that he has sent comforters to you? Is it not for the sake of making a thorough search and causing an overthrow and for spying out the land that his servants have come in to you? (1 Chronicles 19:3)
- Job described his companions as troublesome comforters for they offered no real comfort.
- I have heard many things like these. All of you are troublesome comforters! (Job 16:2)
- Yehowah's Messiah suffers reproach and suffers for he kept hoping for someone to show him sympathy and to comfort him, but no one could be found.
- Reproach itself has broken my heart, and the wound is incurable. And I kept hoping for someone to show sympathy, but there was none, and for comforters, but I found none. (Psalms 69:20)
- And it must occur that everyone seeing you will flee away from you and will certainly say; Nineveh has been despoiled! Who will sympathize with her? From where shall I seek comforters for you? (Nahum 3:7)
