

## ~COMFORTING (50)

[English, reassuring, consoling, calming, kindly, cheering, consoling, encouraging, kind]

- Esau was **comforting** himself to kill his brother Jacob for taking his blessing.
- When the words of Esau her older son were told to Rebekah, she at once sent and called Jacob her younger son and said to him, Look! Esau your brother is **comforting** himself in regard to you, to kill you. (**Genesis 27:42**)
- Isaiah took no **comforting** over the despoiling of the daughter of his people.
- That is why I have said; Turn your gaze away from me. I will show bitterness in weeping. Do not you people insist on **comforting** me over the despoiling of the daughter of my people. (**Isaiah 22:4**)
- Yehowah shows that he is the one **comforting** his people, why therefore would they need to fear men
- I, I myself am the One that is **comforting** you people. Who are you that you should be afraid of a mortal man that will die, and of a son of mankind that will be rendered as mere green grass? (**Isaiah 51:12**)
- Yehowah promised to keep **comforting** his people like a woman **comforts** her son.
- Like a man whom his own mother keeps **comforting**, so I myself shall keep **comforting** you people, and in the case of Jerusalem you will be **comforted**. (**Isaiah 66:13**)
- And Yehowah proceeded to answer the angel who was speaking with me, with good words, **comforting** words. (**Zechariah 1:13**)
- Paul encourages Christians to keep **comforting** one another and building one another up.
- Consequently keep **comforting** one another with these words. (**1**

**Thessalonians 4:18)**

- **Therefore keep comforting one another and building one another up, just as you are in fact doing. (1 Thessalonians 5:11)**
