[English, challenges, defies, taunts, provokes, goads, urges, has the courage, has the guts]

- Judah was prophetically described as a lion cub, who dares to rouse him?
- A lion cub Judah is. From the prey, my son, you will certainly go up. He bowed down, he stretched himself out like a lion and, like a lion, who dares rouse him? (Genesis 49:9)
- Later the same illusion is applied to Israel as a nation.
- He bowed down, he lay down like the lion, and, like a lion, who dares rouse him? Those blessing you are the ones blessed, and those cursing you are the ones cursed. (Numbers 24:9)
- Paul showed that perhaps someone even dares to die for another.
- For hardly will anyone die for a righteous man, indeed, for the good man, perhaps, someone even dares to die. (Romans 5:7)
