- The fruit of the date palm, *Phoenix dactylifera*, a tree common to Palestine. Dates are oval shaped, fleshy, sweet tasting, and produce one seed.
- In the Bible account, dates are mentioned only indirectly. For example, the Shulammite maiden describes the dark locks of her shepherd lovers hair as being like date clusters, bushy, KJ, Hebrew, tal-tal-lim', date-panicles, [Lexicon in Veteris Testamenti Libros, by L. Koehler and W. Baumgartner, Leiden, 1958, p. 1030].
- Solomon likens her stature to a palm tree and her breasts to date clusters, clusters of grapes, KJ and to fruit stalks of dates Hebrew, san-sin-nim'; see [Lexicon in Veteris Testamenti Libros, p. 662].
- His head is gold, refined gold. The locks of his hair are date clusters. His black hair is like the raven. (Song of Solomon 5:11)
- This stature of yours does resemble a palm tree, and your breasts, date clusters. (Song of Solomon 7:7)
- I have said; I shall go up on the palm tree, that I may take hold of its fruit stalks of dates. And, please, may your breasts become like clusters of the vine, and the fragrance of your nose like apples. (Song of Solomon 7:8)
