[English, Last and brightest star to rise on eastern horizon at daybreak]

- The daystar is the last and the brightest star to rise on the eastern horizon at daybreak. Here Peter shows that Christ's coming would be the daystar of Yehowah's Day, the reign of the thousand year Kingdom of God and that his bright spiritual light would be the last **star**, **anointed one**, seen before that day begins.
- When Christians put faith in God's Messiah or Christ then that daystar rises in their hearts and God's Kingdom has begun. Peter also showed that this rising would make the prophetic word more sure through the writings of the Christ.
- Consequently we have the prophetic word made more sure, and you are doing well in paying attention to it as to a lamp shining in a dark place, until day dawns and a **daystar** rises, in your hearts. (2 Peter 1:19)
