## ~DEBORAH 1 (24) (Deb'o-rah) [Bee]

- Rebekah's nurse. When Rebekah left the household of her father Bethuel to move to Palestine and marry Isaac, Deborah accompanied her.
- At that they sent off Rebekah their sister and her nurse and Abraham's servant and his men. (Genesis 24:59)
- After years of service in Isaac's household, Deborah came to be in Jacob's household, perhaps after the death of Rebekah. Evidently some 125 years after Rebekah's marriage to Isaac, Deborah died and was buried under a big tree at Bethel.
- The name given to the tree, Allon-bacuth, meaning Massive Tree of Weeping indicates how beloved she had become to Jacob and his family.
- Later Deborah the nursing woman of Rebekah died and was buried at the foot of Bethel under a massive tree. Hence he called its name Allonbacuth. (Genesis 35:8)
