[English, mislead, tricked, took in, betrayed, lied to, swindled, conned, misinform]

- Eve blamed the serpent for deceiving her, though she knew God's Law.
- With that Yehowah God said to the woman; What is this you have done? To this the woman replied; The serpent, it deceived me and so I ate. (Genesis 3:13)
- At this he said to him; I too am a prophet like you, and an angel himself spoke to me by the word of Yehowah, saying; Have him come back with you to your house that he may eat bread and drink water. He deceived him. (1 Kings 13:18)
- Isaiah prophesied that the princes of Noph had been deceived.
- The princes of Zoan have acted foolishly, the princes of Noph have been deceived, the keymen of her tribes have caused Egypt to wander about. (Isaiah 19:13)
- Jeremiah cried out the Yehowah had absolutely deceived this people because they had put faith in false prophets and Yehowah had let it stand by allowing them to believe it.
- And I proceeded to say; Alas, O Sovereign Lord Yehowah! Truly you have absolutely deceived this people and Jerusalem, saying; Peace itself will become yours, and the sword has reached clear to the soul. (Jeremiah 4:10)
- Edom is spoken of as one who caused shuddering, but their trusting in their stronghold has deceived them for Yehowah will bring them down
- The shuddering you caused has deceived you, the presumptuousness of your heart, O you who are residing in the retreats of the crag, holding the height of the hill. Although you build your nest high up just like an eagle, down from there I shall bring you, is the utterance of Yehowah. (Jeremiah 49:16)
- The presumptuousness of your heart is what has deceived you,

you who are residing in the retreats of the crag, the height where he dwells, saying in his heart, Who will bring me down to the earth? (Obadiah 1:3)

- As far as the boundary they have sent you. The very men in covenant with you have all deceived you. The men at peace with you have prevailed against you. Those eating food with you will place a net under you as one in whom there is no discernment. (Obadiah 1:7)
- The Bible records that Adam was not deceived, but Eve was, and so Adam came to be in transgression.
- Also, Adam was not deceived, but the woman was thoroughly deceived and came to be in transgression. (1 Timothy 2:14)
