~DECEIVE (69)

[English, mislead, trick, take in, betray, lie to, swindle, con, misinform]

- The Law always came out against those who would use deception to gain the upper hand.
- Yehowah and does deceive his associate about something in his charge or a deposit in hand or a robbery or he does defraud his associate. (Leviticus 6:2)
- You must not deceive.
- You people must not steal, and you must not deceive, and you must not deal falsely anyone with his associate. (Leviticus 19:11)
- The Assyrian counseled Jews on the wall of Jerusalem, do not let Hezekiah deceive you.
- This is what the king has said; Do not let Hezekiah deceive you people, for he is not able to deliver you out of my hand. (2 Kings 18:29)
- This is what you men should say to Hezekiah the king of Judah, Do not let your God in whom you are trusting deceive you, saying, Jerusalem will not be given into the hand of the king of Assyria. (2 Kings 19:10)
- And now do not let Hezekiah deceive you or allure you like this and do not put faith in him, for no god of any nation or kingdom was able to deliver his people out of my hand and out of the hand of my forefathers. How much less, then, will your own God deliver you out of my hand? (2 Chronicles 32:15)
- This is what the king has said; Do not let Hezekiah deceive you people, for he is not able to deliver you. (Isaiah 36:14)
- This is what you men should say to Hezekiah the king of Judah, Do not let your God in whom you are trusting deceive you, saying; Jerusalem will not be given into the hand of the king of Assyria. (Isaiah 37:10)

- Jeremiah condemned false prophets who divined Yehowah's will, but who were only deceiving the people by their prophesying.
- For this is what Yehowah of armies, the God of Israel, has said, Let not your prophets who are in among you and your practicers of divination deceive you, and do not you listen to their dreams that they are dreaming. (Jeremiah 29:8)
- They promised peace with Yehowah, but they were only deceiving any who believed in them.
- This is what Yehowah has said; Do not deceive your souls, saying; The Chaldeans will without fail go away from against us, because they will not go away. (Jeremiah 37:9)
- Paul counseled the Ephesians that the wrath of God was coming against the sons of disobedience and anyone speaking to the contrary was deceiving them.
- Let no man deceive you with empty words, for because of the aforesaid things the wrath of God is coming upon the sons of disobedience. (Ephesians 5:6)
