[English, ruining, debasement, ruination, adulteration, corruption, tarnishing, sully, Opposite of, **purification**]

- Nehemiah asked Yehowah to remember Sanballat the Horonite for his **defiling** of the priesthood.
- Do remember them, O my God, on account of the **defilement** of the priesthood and the covenant of the priesthood and of the Levites. (**Nehemiah 13:29**)
- Anointed Christians are promised to be with God, therefore Paul counsels them to cleanse themselves of every **defilement** of flesh and spirit, perfecting holiness in God's fear.
- Therefore, since we have these promises, beloved ones, let us cleanse ourselves of every **defilement** of flesh and spirit, perfecting holiness in God's fear. (**2 Corinthians 7:1**)
- Yehowah expects married men and women to keep their promises to their mates of chastity toward them. Failure to do so is a **defilement** of Christian principles.
- Let marriage be honorable among all, and the marriage bed be without **defilement**, for God will judge fornicators and adulterers. (**Hebrews 13:4**)
