~DEJECTED (57)

[English, sad, unhappy, miserable, depressed, disconsolate, crestfallen, gloomy, down in the mouth]

- Joseph saw two prisoners of Pharaoh sitting there dejected over their dreams.
- When Joseph came in to them in the morning and saw them, why, here they were looking dejected. (Genesis 40:6)
- The king came to feel sullen and dejected.
- At that the king of Israel went on his way toward his house, sullen and dejected, and came to Samaria. (1 Kings 20:43)
- Consequently Ahab came into his house, sullen and dejected over the word that Naboth the Jezreelite had spoken to him, when he said; I shall not give you the hereditary possession of my forefathers. Then he lay down upon his couch and kept his face turned, and he did not eat bread. (1 Kings 21:4)
- The Psalmist showed that the wicked one captures the dejected ones in his trap or net.
- He is crushed, he bows down, and the army of dejected ones has to fall into his strong claws. (Psalms 10:10)
- The Psalmist shows that the wicked do not exercise lovingkindness, but kept pursuing the dejected and afflicted ones, to put them to death.
- For the reason that he did not remember to exercise lovingkindness, but he kept pursuing the afflicted and poor man and the one dejected at heart, to put him to death. (Psalms 109:16)
- Judah came to be dejected over their loss of Yehowah God's favor and blessing.
- Judah has gone mourning, and its very gates have faded away.
 They have become dejected to the earth, and even the outcry of Jerusalem has gone up. (Jeremiah 14:2)

- Ezekiel warned of a report of impending disaster that would make his people become dejected, and every heart would melt.
- And it must occur that, in case they say to you; On account of what are you sighing? You must say; At a report. For it will certainly come, and every heart must melt and all hands must drop down and every spirit must become dejected and all knees themselves will drip with water. Look! It will certainly come and be brought to occur, is the utterance of the Sovereign Lord Yehowah. (Ezekiel 21:7)
