- Jereboam took from the people any man who was **delighting** in being a priest to serve.
- After this thing Jeroboam did not turn back from his bad way, but he again went making priests of high places from the people in general. As for anyone **delighting** in it, he would fill his hand with power, saying; And let him become one of the priests of high places. (**1 Kings 13:33**)

- The works of Yehowah are great, searched for on the part of all those **delighting** in them. (**Psalms 111:2**)
- Yehowah is a God who **delights** in loving-kindness.
- Who is a God like you, one pardoning error and passing over transgression of the remnant of his inheritance? He will certainly
