[English, release, liberation, rescue, relief, escape, freedom delivery, Opposite of, capture]

- David always depended upon Yehowah asking for his direction and Yehowah promised deliverance for him.
- And David began to inquire of Yehowah, saying; Shall I chase after this marauder band? Shall I overtake them? At this he said to him, Go in chase, for you will without fail overtake them, and you will without fail make a deliverance. (1 Samuel 30:8)
- Esther was encouraged to stand up for her people for if she failed to then deliverance would stand up from another quarter.
- For if you are altogether silent at this time, relief and deliverance themselves will stand up for the Jews from another place, but as for you and your father's house, you people will perish. And who is there knowing whether it is for a time like this that you have attained to royal dignity? (Esther 4:14)
- Yehowah God is the Almighty and there is no one who can provide deliverance out of his hand
- Also, all the time I am the same One, and there is no one effecting deliverance out of my own hand. I shall get active, and who can turn it back? (Isaiah 43:13)
- Zion is spoken of as a woman who gives deliverance to the male child before she even feels pangs of birth.
- Before she began to come into labor pains she gave birth. Before birth pangs could come to her, she even gave deliverance to a male child. (Isaiah 66:7)
- And they will actually shepherd the land of Assyria with the sword, and the land of Nimrod in its entrances. And he will certainly bring about deliverance from the Assyrian, when he comes into our land and when he treads upon our territory. (Micah 5:6)

- Zechariah blessed Yehowah who had turned his attention to his people and effected deliverance for them.
- Blessed be Yehowah the God of Israel, because he has turned his attention and performed deliverance toward his people. (Luke 1:68)
- And in that very hour she came near and began returning thanks to God and speaking about the child to all those waiting for Jerusalem's deliverance. (Luke 2:38)
- Jesus showed that when his disciples saw signs in the Sun, Moon and Stars that their deliverance was getting near.
- But as these things start to occur, raise yourselves erect and lift your heads up, because your deliverance is getting near. (Luke 21:28)
- Jesus entered into the heavenly realm with his own blood to effect a deliverance for Christians.
- He entered, no, not with the blood of goats and of young bulls, but with his own blood, once for all time into the holy place and obtained an everlasting deliverance for us. (Hebrews 9:12)
