

~DEMANDED (33)

[English, insisted, commanded, ordered, required, stipulated, exacted, claimed, Opposite of, requested]

- More will be **demanded** of those who are given much.
- But the one that did not understand and so did things deserving of strokes will be beaten with few. Indeed, everyone to whom much was given, much will be **demanded** of him, and the one whom people put in charge of much, they will **demand** more than usual of him. (Luke 12:48)
- Satan **demanded** of God to have all of Jesus disciples to sift them as wheat.
- Simon, Simon, look! Satan has **demanded** to have you men to sift you as wheat. (Luke 22:31)
- The Israelites **demanded** a king from Samuel and Yehowah gave them Saul at first.
- But from then on they **demanded** a king, and God gave them Saul son of Kish, a man of the tribe of Benjamin, for forty years. (Acts of Apostles 13:21)
- Although no guilt worthy of death was found in Jesus still the Jews **demanded** he be executed.
- And, although they found no cause for death, they **demanded** of Pilate that he be executed. (Acts of Apostles 13:28)
