- More will be demanded of those who are given much.
- But the one that did not understand and so did things deserving of strokes will be beaten with few. Indeed, everyone to whom much was given, much will be demanded of him, and the one whom people put in charge of much, they will demand more than usual of him. (Luke 12:48)
- Satan demanded of God to have all of Jesus disciples to sift them as wheat.
- Simon, Simon, look! Satan has demanded to have you men to sift you as wheat. (Luke 22:31)
- The Israelites demanded a king from Samuel and Yehowah gave them Saul at first.
- But from then on they demanded a king, and God gave them Saul son of Kish, a man of the tribe of Benjamin, for forty years. (Acts of Apostles 13:21)
- Although no guilt worthy of death was found in Jesus still the Jews demanded he by executed.
- And, although they found no cause for death, they demanded of Pilate that he be executed. (Acts of Apostles 13:28)
