

~DEMANDING (25)

[English, difficult, hard, challenging, tough, severe, serious, Opposite of, easy]

- Jesus showed that one was unreasonable who stored up great wealth but took no time to know God. When God **demanded** his soul who then would have the things he stored up?
- But God said to him, unreasonable one, this night they are **demanding** your soul from you. Who, then, is to have the things you stored up? (**Luke 12:20**)
- The Jews **demanded** with loud voices the impalement of Jesus.
- At this they began to be urgent, with loud voices, **demanding** that he be impaled, and their voices began to win out. (**Luke 23:23**)
- They also **demanded** that they release a known murderer.
- He released the man that had been thrown into prison for sedition and murder and whom they were **demanding**, but he surrendered Jesus to their will. (**Luke 23:25**)
