- Nehemiah, though due a stipend for his service as governor did not demand one.
- As for that which happened to be made ready daily, one bull, six select sheep and birds were made ready for me, and once every ten days every sort of wine in abundance. And along with this the bread due the governor I did not demand, because the service upon this people was heavy. (Nehemiah 5:18)
- John the Baptist told those coming to him who were tax collectors, do not demand anything more than the tax rate
- He said to them; Do not demand anything more than the tax rate. (Luke 3:13)
- Pilate capitulated to pressure from the Jews and gave sentence for their demand to be mention.
- So Pilate gave sentence for their demand to be met. (Luke 23:24)
