

~DERIDE (25)

[English, ridicule, scoff, put down, disparage, mock, scorn, disdain, knock, Opposite of, **approve**]

- Sanballat and Tobiah **derided** the work of Nehemiah.
- Now when Sanballat the Horonite and Tobiah the servant, the Ammonite, and Geshem the Arabian heard of it, they began to **deride** us and look on us despisingly and say; What is this thing that you are doing? Is it against the king that you are rebelling? (**Nehemiah 2:19**)
- Job asked for silence so that he might speak and then his **comforters** could **deride** him.
- Put up with me, and I myself shall speak, and after my speaking you may each **deride**. (**Job 21:3**)
- Yehowah himself will **deride** ridiculers, but to the meek ones he shows favor
- If it has to do with ridiculers, he himself will **deride**, but to the meek ones he will show favor. (**Proverbs 3:34**)
