[English, ridicule, scoff, put down, disparage, mock, scorn, disdain, knock, Opposite of, approve]

- Sanballat and Tobiah derided the work of Nehemiah.
- Now when Sanballat the Horonite and Tobiah the servant, the Ammonite, and Geshem the Arabian heard of it, they began to deride us and look on us despisingly and say; What is this thing that you are doing? Is it against the king that you are rebelling? (Nehemiah 2:19)
- Job asked for silence so that he might speak and then his comforters could deride him.
- Put up with me, and I myself shall speak, and after my speaking you may each deride. (Job 21:3)
- Yehowah himself will deride ridiculers, but to the meek ones he shows favor
- If it has to do with ridiculers, he himself will deride, but to the meek ones he will show favor. (Proverbs 3:34)
