

~DERISION (116)

**[English, scorn, disdain, mockery, ridicule, contempt, disrespect,
Opposite of, approval]**

- Hezekiah was told by Isaiah that the virgin daughter of Zion held the Assyrian armies in **derision**.
- This is the word that Yehowah has spoken against him; The virgin daughter of Zion has despised you, she has held you in **derision**. Behind you the daughter of Jerusalem has wagged her head. (**2 Kings 19:21**)
- Job was an able-bodied man who drank up **derision** like water, showing his mild temper, and his ability other take counsel and criticism.
- What able-bodied man is like Job, who drinks up **derision** like water? (**Job 34:7**)
- When the nations turn against Yehowah, when he appoints his son to rule the earth in righteousness, Yehowah God will look down upon their rebellion holding them in **derision**, for no one will be able to resist the power of his kingdom to rule the earth.
- The very One sitting in the heavens will laugh. Yehowah himself will hold them in **derision**. (**Psalms 2:4**)
- The Psalmist spoke prophetically of the Messiah and how men would come to view him, and to treat him.
- As for all those seeing me, they hold me in **derision**, they keep opening their mouths wide, they keep wagging their head. (**Psalms 22:7**)
- The Jews were set as a reproach and a **derision** before their neighbor nations, when their nation was sent into exile.
- You set us as a reproach to our neighbors, a **derision** and jeering to those all around us. (**Psalms 44:13**)
- We have become a reproach to our neighbors, a **derision** and a jeering to those round about us. (**Psalms 79:4**)

- Abundantly our soul has been gluttoned with the **derision** of those who are at ease, of the contempt on the part of the arrogant ones. (**Psalms 123:4**)
- Yehowah will hold nation who resist his coming kingdom in **derision** for their lack of faith.
- But you yourself, O Yehowah, will laugh at them; You will hold all the nations in **derision**. (**Psalms 59:8**)
- Foolish are those who make a **derision** out of their guilt.
- Foolish are those who make a **derision** of guilt, but among the upright ones there is agreement. (**Proverbs 14:9**)
- Anyone holding a man of little means in derision, because he is poor, had reproached his creator, Yehowah God.
- He that is holding the one of little means in **derision** has reproached his Maker. He that is joyful at another's disaster will not be free from punishment. (**Proverbs 17:5**)
- The ravens will eat out the eyes of anyone holding his own father and mother in **derision**.
- The eye that holds a father in **derision** and that despises obedience to a mother, the ravens of the torrent valley will pick it out and the sons of the eagle will eat it up. (**Proverbs 30:17**)
- Isaiah showed, that Yehowah held the Assyrian taunts and threats in **derision**, for he himself would come to the aid of his people and fight for them.
- This is the word that Yehowah has spoken against him; The virgin daughter of Zion has despised you, she has held you in **derision**. Behind you the daughter of Jerusalem has wagged her head. (**Isaiah 37:22**)
- Jeremiah complained that Yehowah God had made him an object of laughter and **derision** all day long, for carrying forth his word.
- You have fooled me, O Yehowah, so that I was fooled. You used your strength against me, so that you prevailed. I became an

object of laughter all day long, everyone is holding me in **derision**. (Jeremiah 20:7)

- Judah was told that she would drink the cup of her sister Israel, and that she also would become an object of laughter and **derision**, among the nations.
- This is what the Sovereign Lord Yehowah has said; The cup of your sister you will drink, the deep and wide one. You will become an object of laughter and **derision**, the cup containing much. (Ezekiel 23:32)
- The princes of Israel turned around time and again like a loose bow in Yehowah God's hands, and so they would be exiled and become an object of **derision** in a foreign land.
- And they proceeded to return, not to anything higher, they had become like a loose bow. By the sword their princes will fall because of the denunciation of their tongue. This will be their **derision** in the land of Egypt. (Hosea 7:16)
