

~DESERVES (28)

[English, merits, is worthy of, ought to have, earns, warrants, justifies]

- When a wicked one **deserved** to be beaten he was laid prostrate and beaten before the judge.
- And it must occur that if the wicked one **deserves** to be beaten, the judge must also have him laid prostrate and given strokes before him by number to correspond with his wicked deed. (**Deuteronomy 25:2**)
- When Nathan confronted David over his sin with Bathsheba, David said that the man doing, what he himself had done, was **deserving** of death.
- At this David's anger grew very hot against the man, so that he said to Nathan; As Yehowah is living, the man doing this **deserves** to die! (**2 Samuel 12:5**)
- Jesus showed that those doing the Lords work **deserve** their food.
- Or a food pouch for the trip, or two undergarments, or sandals or a staff, for the worker **deserves** his food. (**Matthew 10:10**)
