[English, merits, is worthy of, ought to have, earns, warrants, justifies]

- When a wicked one deserved to be beaten he was laid prostrate and beaten before the judge.
- And it must occur that if the wicked one deserves to be beaten, the judge must also have him laid prostrate and given strokes before him by number to correspond with his wicked deed.

 (Deuteronomy 25:2)
- When Nathan confronted David over his sin with Bathsheba,
 David said that the man doing, what he himself had done, was deserving of death.
- At this David's anger grew very hot against the man, so that he said to Nathan; As Yehowah is living, the man doing this deserves to die! (2 Samuel 12:5)
- Jesus showed that those doing the Lords work deserve their food.
- Or a food pouch for the trip, or two undergarments, or sandals or a staff, for the worker deserves his food. (Matthew 10:10)
