- The lazy one has **desires**, but they remain unfilled, while the diligent ones is made fat.
- The lazy one is showing himself **desirous**, but his soul has nothing. However, the very soul of the diligent ones will be made fat. (**Proverbs 13:4**)
- Paul showed that after his first examination they were **desirous** of releasing him.
- And these, after making an examination, were **desirous** of releasing me, as there was no cause for death in me. (**Acts of Apostles 28:18**)
- Paul encouraged Christians to be zealously **desirous** the gifts of the spirit for the upbuilding of the congregations.
- So also you yourselves, since you are zealously **desirous** of gifts of the spirit, seek to abound in them for the upbuilding of the congregation. (**1 Corinthians 14:12**)
- Paul showed that any man reaching out for the office of overseer was **desirous** of a fine work.
- That statement is faithful. If any man is reaching out for an office of overseer, he is **desirous** of a fine work. (**1 Timothy 3:1**)
