- Yehowah's great day of vengeance will bring about an end of the desolations of God's people for the very name of wicked ones will perish.
- O you enemy, your desolations have come to their perpetual finish, and the cities that you have uprooted. The very mention of them will certainly perish. (Psalms 9:6)
- Desolations be upon them! Let them go down into Sheol alive, for during their alien residence bad things have been within them. (Psalms 55:15)
- Do lift up your steps to the long-lasting desolations. Everything the enemy has treated badly in the holy place. (Psalms 74:3)
- For the very waters of Nimrim become sheer desolations. For the green grass has dried up, the grass has come to an end. Nothing has become green. (Isaiah 15:6)
