~DESPICABLE (46)

[English, appalling, dreadful, contemptible, wicked, shameful, disgraceful, vile, loathsome, Opposite of, admirable]

- Though Saul was instructed to devote all of Agag to destruction, he only devoted to destruction the thing despicable and preserved all others.
- But Saul and the people had compassion upon Agag and upon the best of the flock and the herd and the fat ones and upon the rams and upon all that was good, and they did not wish to devote them to destruction. As for all the goods that were despicable and rejected, these they devoted to destruction. (1 Samuel 15:9)
- Haman hated Mordecai's people and viewed him as despicable.
- But it was despicable in his eyes to lay hand upon Mordecai alone, for they had told him about Mordecai's people, and Haman began seeking to annihilate all the Jews who were in all the realm of Ahasuerus, Mordecai's people. (Esther 3:6)
- Yehowah's Messiah prophetically is shown to be a worm of a man and a reproach to men and despicable to the people.
- But I am a worm, and not a man, a reproach to men and despicable to the people. (Psalms 22:6)
- Yehowah promises to throw disgusting things upon her and make her despicable before others as a spectacle.
- And I will throw disgusting things upon you, and I will make you despicable, and I will set you as a spectacle. (Nahum 3:6)
- Jesus stated that anyone calling his brother a despicable fool would be liable to the fiery Gehenna.
- However, I say to you that everyone who continues wrathful with his brother will be accountable to the court of justice, but whoever addresses his brother with an unspeakable word of contempt will be accountable to the Supreme Court, whereas whoever says; You despicable fool! Will be liable to the fiery Gehenna. (Matthew 5:22)
