[English, loathing, scornful, looking down on, hating, spurning, deriding, Opposite of, admiring]

- Yehowah called the house of Eli to account because those despising me will be of little account.
- That is why the utterance of Yehowah the God of Israel is: I did indeed say; As for your house and the house of your forefather, they will walk before me to time indefinite. But now the utterance of Yehowah is; It is unthinkable, on my part, because those honoring me I shall honor, and those despising me will be of little account. (1 Samuel 2:30)
- The Philistines despised David because he proved to be a young boy ruddy in appearance.
- Now when the Philistine looked and saw David, he began despising him because he proved to be a boy and ruddy, of beautiful appearance. (1 Samuel 17:42)
- The Israelites were continually making jest of the messengers of the true God and despising his words.
- But they were continually making jest at the messengers of the true God and despising his words and mocking at his prophets, until the rage of Yehowah came up against his people, until there was no healing. (2 Chronicles 36:16)
- Men who refuses to walk in Yehowah's ways despise him.
- The one walking in his uprightness is fearing Yehowah, but the one crooked in his ways is despising Him. (Proverbs 14:2)
- It is a sin to despise ones fellowman, but the one showing favor to the afflicted ones imitates his God.
- The one despising his own fellowman is sinning, but happy is he who is showing favor to the afflicted ones. (Proverbs 14:21)
- A stupid man is despising his mother.

- A wise son is the one that makes a father rejoice, but a stupid man is despising his mother. (Proverbs 15:20)
- He that is **despising** Yehowah's ways will be put to death.
- He that is keeping the commandment is keeping his soul, he that is despising his ways will be put to death. (Proverbs 19:16)
- The loyal ones have perished from the earth and a son is despising his father.
- For a son is despising a father, a daughter is rising up against her mother, a daughter-in-law against her mother-in-law, a man's enemies are the men of his household. (Micah 7:6)
- Yehowah called the priests to account for despising his name.
- A son, for his part, honors a father. A servant, honors his grand master. So if I am a father, where is the honor to me? And if I am a grand master, where is the fear of me? Yehowah of armies has said to you, O priests who are despising my name. And you have said, In what way have we despised your name? (Malachi 1:6)
- Jesus despised shame thus suffering through a torture stake execution though not guilty of anything.
- As we look intently at the Chief Agent and Perfecter of our faith, Jesus. For the joy that was set before him he endured a torture stake, despising shame, and has sat down at the right hand of the throne of God. (Hebrews 12:2)
