~DESPOILER (100)

[English, One Who, dishonors, desecrates, sullies, violates, debases]

- The wicked one is always fearing dreadful things, and during peace a despoiler comes upon him.
- The sound of dreadful things is in his ears, during peace a despoiler himself comes upon him. (Job 15:21)
- Isaiah requested Moab to become a place of concealment for those of Israel fleeing from the despoiler.
- May my dispersed ones reside as aliens even in you, O Moab.
 Become a place of concealment to them because of the despoiler.
 For the oppressor has reached his end, the despoiling has terminated, those trampling down others have been finished off the earth. (Isaiah 16:4)
- Isaiah saw a hard vision in which the despoiler was going forth despoiling, relating to the fall of Babylon to the Medes and Persians.
- There is a hard vision that has been told to me. The treacherous dealer is dealing treacherously, and the despoiler is despoiling. Go up, O Elam! Lay siege, O Media! All sighing due to her I have caused to cease. (Isaiah 21:2)
- Isaiah showed, that only woe would come to those who despoil others without themselves first being despoiled.
- Woe to you who are despoiling, without you yourself being despoiled, and to you who are dealing treacherously, without others having dealt treacherously with you! As soon as you have finished as a despoiler, you will be despoiled. As soon as you have done with dealing treacherously, they will deal treacherously with you. (Isaiah 33:1)
- Jeremiah told the daughter of Jerusalem, those hoping in truth and fine principles of righteousness, to go into mourning, because suddenly the despoiler would come in upon them.
- O daughter of my people, gird on sackcloth and wallow in the ashes. Make your mourning that for an only son, the wailing of

bitterness, because suddenly the despoiler will come upon us. (Jeremiah 6:26)

- Jeremiah prophesied that Yehowah God would bring upon his people the despoiler at midday.
- To me their widows have become more numerous than the sand grains of the seas. I will bring for them, upon mother, young man, the despoiler at midday. I will cause to fall upon them suddenly excitement and disturbances. (Jeremiah 15:8)
- Jeremiah showed that Israel's despoiler would come into every city, and not one of them could make an escape.
- And the despoiler will come in on every city, and there will be no city that can make its escape. And the low plain will certainly perish and the level land be annihilated, a thing that Yehowah has said. (Jeremiah 48:8)
- The daughter of Dibon was told to get down off her throne for the despoiler of Moab has come upon her also.
- Get down from glory, and sit down in thirst, O inhabitress of the daughter of Dibon, for the despoiler of Moab has come up against you. He will actually bring your fortified places to ruin.

 (Jeremiah 48:18)
- Jeremiah prophesied that the despoiler would come up against the vine of Sibmah during the harvesttime.
- With more than the weeping for Jazer I shall weep for you, O vine of Sibmah. Your own flourishing shoots have crossed over the sea. To the sea, to Jazer, they have reached. Upon your summer fruitage and upon your grape gathering the despoiler himself has fallen. (Jeremiah 48:32)
- Jeremiah prophesied that the despoiler would eventually come upon Babylon and her mighty men would be captured, as a recompense from Yehowah God.
- For there must come upon her, upon Babylon, the despoiler, and her mighty men will certainly be captured. Their bows must be shattered, for Yehowah is a God of recompenses. Without fail he will repay. (Jeremiah 51:56)
