~DESPOILING (282)

[English, damaging, spoiling, desecrating, defiling, ruining, wrecking, vandalizing, defacing, plundering]

- Job showed that a righteous one will not be afraid of words used against him, nor of despoiling when it comes.
- From the whip of a tongue you will be hidden, and you will not be afraid of despoiling when it comes. (Job 5:21)
- At despoiling and hunger you will laugh, and of the wild beast of the earth you need not be afraid. (Job 5:22)
- Yehowah God promises to arise because of the despoiling of the afflicted ones of the earth, protecting them from anyone who puffs against them.
- Because of the despoiling of the afflicted ones, because of the sighing of the poor ones, I shall at this time arise, says Yehowah. I shall put him in safety from anyone that puffs at him. (Psalms 12:5)
- The despoiling done by the wicked ones will itself drag them away, for they have refused to do justice.
- The very despoiling by the wicked ones will drag them away, for they have refused to do justice. (Proverbs 21:7)
- The wicked ones keep meditating upon despoiling, and their lips speak trouble and hurtfulness.
- For despoiling is what their heart keeps meditating, and trouble is what their own lips keep speaking. (Proverbs 24:2)
- The great Day of Yehowah will come in as a despoiling, not something that people will want to experience.
- Howl, you people, for the day of Yehowah is near! As a despoiling from the Almighty it will come. (Isaiah 13:6)

- Isaiah asked for Moab to become a place of concealment for the escaped ones of Israel, who were fleeing from the despoiler, for the despoiling by him had come to completion.
- May my dispersed ones reside as aliens even in you, O Moab.
 Become a place of concealment to them because of the despoiler.
 For the oppressor has reached his end, the despoiling has terminated, those trampling down others have been finished off the earth. (Isaiah 16:4)
- Isaiah saw a hard vision of a despoiler who was despoiling, Elam and Media despoiling Babylon.
- There is a hard vision that has been told to me. The treacherous dealer is dealing treacherously, and the despoiler is despoiling. Go up, O Elam! Lay siege, O Media! All sighing due to her I have caused to cease. (Isaiah 21:2)
- Isaiah refused to take comfort from his people over the despoiling of his people.
- That is why I have said; Turn your gaze away from me. I will show bitterness in weeping. Do not you people insist on comforting me over the despoiling of the daughter of my people. (Isaiah 22:4)
- Only woe will come to anyone despoiling others, without himself first being despoiled.
- Woe to you who are despoiling, without you yourself being despoiled, and to you who are dealing treacherously, without others having dealt treacherously with you! As soon as you have finished as a despoiler, you will be despoiled. As soon as you have done with dealing treacherously, they will deal treacherously with you. (Isaiah 33:1)
- Isaiah showed that Israel would find no comforters from the despoiling coming upon her.
- Those two things were befalling you. Who will sympathize with you? Despoiling and breakdown, and hunger and sword! Who will comfort you? (Isaiah 51:19)
- The highways of the wicked one are despoiling and breakdown.

- Their own feet keep running to sheer badness, and they are in a hurry to shed innocent blood. Their thoughts are hurtful thoughts, despoiling and breakdown are in their highways. (Isaiah 59:7)
- Yehowah promised through Isaiah that in his New Order despoiling and breakdown would no longer be heard within the boundaries of his people.
- No more will violence be heard in your land, despoiling or breakdown within your boundaries. And you will certainly call your own walls Salvation and your gates Praise. (Isaiah 60:18)
- Yehowah God sent wild animals to despoil his people, for they acted beastlike toward those under them, and their transgressions and acts of faithlessness were numerous.
- That is why a lion out of the forest has struck them, a wolf itself of the desert plains keeps despoiling them, a leopard is keeping awake at their cities. Everyone going forth from them gets torn to pieces. For their transgressions have become many, their acts of unfaithfulness have become numerous. (Jeremiah 5:6)
- Jeremiah illustrated how Israel kept her violence and badness cool, like waters within a deep cistern, but violence and despoiling continued to be heard within her.
- As a cistern keeps its waters cool, so she has kept her badness cool. Violence and despoiling are heard in her, sickness and plague are before my face constantly. (Jeremiah 6:7)
- Jeremiah called out time and again that violence and despoiling were happening among his people Israel, who simply jeered all day long at his prophesying, making him an object of reproach.
- For as often as I speak, I cry out. Violence and despoiling are what I call out. For the word of Yehowah became for me a cause for reproach and for jeering all day long. (Jeremiah 20:8)
- Jeremiah foretold the howling of the majestic shepherds of the flock, for Yehowah God is despoiling their very pasturage.
- Listen! The outcry of the shepherds, and the howling of the

majestic ones of the flock, for Yehowah is despoiling their pasturage. (Jeremiah 25:36)

- Jeremiah foretold a day of despoiling for the Philistines along the seacoast.
- On account of the day that is coming to despoil all the Philistines, to cut off from Tyre and from Sidon every survivor that was helping. For Yehowah is despoiling the Philistines, who are the remaining ones from the island of Caphtor. (Jeremiah 47:4)
- Jeremiah prophesied an outcry from Horonaim, and despoiling and breakdown coming from there.
- There is the sound of an outcry from Horonaim, a despoiling and great breaking down. (Jeremiah 48:3)
- Yehowah promised to despoil Babylon, and take away from her, her great voice.
- For Yehowah is despoiling Babylon, and he will certainly destroy out of her the great voice, and their waves will actually be boisterous like many waters. The noise of their voice will certainly be given out (Jeremiah 51:55)
- Ezekiel called for the chieftains of Israel to remove the violence and despoiling they were carrying on among the people, and to do justice and righteousness.
- This is what the Sovereign Lord Yehowah has said; That is enough of you, O chieftains of Israel! Remove the violence and the despoiling, and do justice and righteousness themselves. Lift your expropriations off my people, is the utterance of the Sovereign Lord Yehowah. (Ezekiel 45:9)
- Hosea showed that Israel would experience despoiling from Yehowah God because they had transgressed against him.
- Woe to them, for they have fled from me! Despoiling to them, for they have transgressed against me! And I myself proceeded to redeem them, but they themselves have spoken lies even against me. (Hosea 7:13)

- Yehowah promises his people that they will have to go off of their Promised Land, because of the despoiling he is bringing upon them, for their wickedness. Down to Egypt, Ephraim will depart, where he will come to reside in Memphis, and there he will die and be buried. As for all their desirable articles of false worship, their idol collections covered in gold and silver, they will come to be overrun by thorny bushes and nettles in their own tents. Their entire way of worship, their entire way, will come nothing, for it was always an unreality!
- For, look! They will have to go because of despoiling. Egypt itself will collect them together, Memphis, for its part, will bury them. As for their desirable things of silver, nettles themselves will take possession of them, thorny bushes will be in their tents. (Hosea 9:6)
- Hosea showed that Israel would be despoiled similar to the despoiling caused by Shalman.
- And an uproar has risen among your people, and your own fortified cities will all be despoiled, as with the despoiling by Shalman of the house of Arbel, in the day of battle when a mother herself was dashed to pieces alongside her own sons. (Hosea 10:14)
- Ephraim was chasing after wind, for lying and despoiling were the things he multiplied within him.
- Ephraim is feeding on wind and chasing after the east wind all day long. Lying and despoiling are what he multiplies. And a covenant with Assyria they conclude, and to Egypt oil itself is brought. (Hosea 12:1)
- The Great Day of Yehowah will come in like a despoiling from Yehowah God.
- Alas for the day, because the day of Yehowah is near, and like a despoiling from the Almighty One it will come! (Joel 1:15)
- Yehowah showed that those storing up violence and despoiling, do not know how to do what is straightforward.
- And they have not known how to do what is straighforward, is the utterance of Yehowah, those who are storing up violence and despoiling in their dwelling towers. (Amos 3:10)

- He who is doing a despoiling, will flash forth upon someone strong and against his fortified places.
- He who is causing a despoiling to flash forth upon someone strong, that despoiling itself may come upon even a fortified place. (Amos 5:9)
- Habakkuk asked why he had to look continually upon violence and despoiling and trouble.
- Why is it that you make me see what is hurtful, and you keep looking upon mere trouble? And why are despoiling and violence in front of me, and why does quarreling occur, and why is strife carried? (Habakkuk 1:3)
- Next Yehowah tells Zechariah, that after the glory of their return to the Promised Land, and the restoration of pure worship in the earth, then he has sent his prophet to the nations, that were despoiling his people Israel, for Yehowah God considers anyone touching his people, as someone who is touching his own eyeball. He will be very aware and quite sensitive to any attempts to hurt them. Thus Yehowah will then turn his attention to the wicked nations of the earth who have abused his people Israel.
- For this is what Yehowah of armies has said; Following after the glory he has sent me to the nations that were despoiling you people, for he that is touching you is touching my eyeball. (Zechariah 2:8)
