~DESPOIL (122)

[English, damage, spoil, desecrate, defile, ruin, wreck, vandalize, deface, plunder]

- Wicked men despoil the vineyard of wicked ones.
- In the field its fodder they harvest, and the vineyard of the wicked one they hastily despoil. (Job 24:6)
- The distortion by those dealings treacherously is what will despoil them.
- The integrity of the upright ones is what leads them, but distortion by those dealing treacherously will despoil them. (Proverbs 11:3)
- Wicked men should not lie in wait for the righteous one to despoil his resting place.
- Do not, as a wicked one, lie in wait for the abiding place of the righteous one, do not despoil his resting-place. (Proverbs 24:15)
- Jeremiah spoke of a day of despoiling coming from Yehowah God against the Philistines along the seacoast.
- On account of the day that is coming to despoil all the Philistines, to cut off from Tyre and from Sidon every survivor that was helping. For Yehowah is despoiling the Philistines, who are the remaining ones from the island of Caphtor. (Jeremiah 47:4)
- Kedar is told to rise up in warfare and to despoil the sons of the East.
- For Kedar and the kingdoms of Hazor, which Nebuchadrezzar the king of Babylon struck down, this is what Yehowah has said; Rise up, go up to Kedar, O men, and despoil the sons of the East. (Jeremiah 49:28)
- Yehowah God told Egypt through Ezekiel, that he would cause their crowd to fall by the sword, and they would actually despoil the pride of Egypt.

- I shall cause your crowd to fall by the very swords of mighty ones, the tyrants of the nations, all of them, and they will actually despoil the pride of Egypt, and all her crowd must be annihilated. (Ezekiel 32:12)
- Hosea spoke of one, likely Yehowah God, who would despoil their altars to false worship and their pillars.
- Their heart has become hypocritical, now they will be found guilty. There is one who will break their altars. He will despoil their pillars. (Hosea 10:2)
- Those who have despoiled others will themselves be despoiled.
- Because you yourself despoiled many nations, all the remaining ones of the peoples will despoil you, because of the shedding of blood of mankind and the violence to the earth, the town and all those dwelling in it. (Habakkuk 2:8)
