[English, strong-minded, resolute, gritty, single-minded, unwavering, firm, dogged, indominatable, Opposite of, irresolute]

- Yehowah was quite determined to get the facts concerning the outcry against Sodom and Gomorrah, before making any judgment of her.
- I am quite determined to go down that I may see whether they act altogether according to the outcry over it that has come to me, and, if not, I can get to know it. (Genesis 18:21)
- When Jephthah saw that there was no savior he was determined to trust in his own strength and go against the sons of Ammon.
- When I got to see that you were no savior, then I determined to put my soul in my own palm and go over against the sons of Ammon. At that Yehowah gave them into my hand. So why have you come up against me this day to fight against me? (Judges 12:3)
- David knew, that if Saul showed anger at David's being absent from Saul's court, then he knew that something bad had been determined upon him by Saul.
- If the way he should say is; It is all right! It means peace to your servant. But if he should at all become angry, know that what is bad has been determined upon by him. (1 Samuel 20:7)
- Jonathan, David's friend determined to protect David and keep him informed of his father's plans.
- To this Jonathan said; That is unthinkable respecting you! But if I should at all get to know that evil has been determined upon by my father to come upon you, shall I not tell it to you? (1 Samuel 20:9)
- Saul was determined to put David to death, trying to strike him with a spear.
- At that Saul went hurling the spear at him to strike him, and Jonathan came to know that it had been determined upon by his

father to put David to death. (1 Samuel 20:33)

- Abagail learned that calamity had been determined against her household by David and his men, because her husband failed to assist them.
- And now know and see what you are going to do, for calamity has been determined against our master and against all his house, as he is too much of a good-for-nothing fellow to speak to him. (1 Samuel 25:17)
- David was determined to glorify Yehowah God above himself.
- And I will make myself even more lightly esteemed than this, and I will become low in my eyes, and with the slave girls whom you mentioned, with them I am determined to glorify myself. (2 Samuel 6:22)
- Haman saw that bad had been determined against him by the king.
- As for the king, he rose up in his rage from the banquet of wine to go to the garden of the palace, and Haman himself stood up to make request for his soul from Esther the queen, for he saw that bad had been determined against him by the king. (Esther 7:7)
- Daniel determined not to pollute himself with the delicacies of the king.
- But Daniel determined in his heart that he would not pollute himself with the delicacies of the king and with his drinking wine. And he kept requesting of the principal court official that he might not pollute himself. (Daniel 1:8)
- Seventy weeks had been determined upon the Jews to terminate transgression and to finish off sin.
- There are seventy weeks that have been determined upon your people and upon your holy city, in order to terminate the transgression, and to finish off sin, and to make atonement for error, and to bring in righteousness for times indefinite, and to imprint a seal upon vision and prophet, and to anoint the Holy of Holies. (Daniel 9:24)

- Jesus was delivered upon by the determined counsel and foreknowledge of Yehowah God to be a sacrifice for all mankind.
- This man, as one delivered up by the determined counsel and foreknowledge of God, you fastened to a stake by the hand of lawless men and did away with. (Acts of Apostles 2:23)
- The apostles were determined to bring the blood of Jesus Christ upon the Jewish religious leaders for they were the instigators of his death.
- And said; We positively ordered you not to keep teaching upon the basis of this name, and yet, look! You have filled Jerusalem with your teaching, and you are determined to bring the blood of this man upon us. (Acts of Apostles 5:28)
- The disciples in foreign lands determined to send a relief ministration to the Christians in Judea.
- So those of the disciples determined, each of them according as anyone could afford it, to send a relief ministration to the brothers dwelling in Judea. (Acts of Apostles 11:29)
- Barnabas was determined to bring Mark along on the second missionary tour with Paul and himself.
- For his part, Barnabas was determined to take along also John, who was called Mark. (Acts of Apostles 15:37)
- The sailors were determined to beach the boat in a certain bay.
- Finally when it became day, they could not recognize the land but they were observing a certain bay with a beach, and on this they were determined, if they could, to beach the boat. (Acts of Apostles 27:39)
- Those who are determined to be rich, fall into a snare or trap, and many senseless and hurtful desires, leading to their ruin.
- However, those who are determined to be rich fall into temptation and a snare and many senseless and hurtful desires, which plunge men into destruction and ruin. (1 Timothy 6:9)
