[English, diverge, move away, stray, depart, swerve, turn, turn aside, digress, differ]

- Job stated that from the way of Yehowah he did not **deviate**.
- Of his steps my foot has laid hold. His way I have kept, and I do not **deviate**. (**Job 23:11**)
- The Psalmist likewise kept walking in faith and did not **deviate** from Yehowah's path or way.
- Our heart has not turned faithlessly back, nor do our footsteps **deviate** from your path. (**Psalms 44:18**)
- The men of Isaiah's day wanted Yehowah to change to accommodate them saying; **Deviate** from the path.
- Turn aside from the way, **deviate** from the path. Cause the Holy One of Israel to cease just on account of us. (**Isaiah 30:11**)
