

~DEVOURS (35)

[English, eats greedily, consumes, gets through, demolishes, disposes of, gulps down]

- The Psalmist describes Yehowah's presence where before him a fire **devours** all around.
- Our God will come and cannot possibly keep silent. Before him there **devours** a fire, and all around him it has become exceedingly stormy weather. (**Psalms 50:3**)
- Ezekiel used the illustration of a vine tree thrown into a fire. Is it fit for any work.
- Look! Into the fire is where it must be put for fuel. Both ends of it the fire certainly **devours**, and the very middle of it does get scorched. Is it fit for any work? (**Ezekiel 15:4**)
- Paul counseled the Corinthian Christians not to accept whoever enslaves or **devours** them.
- In fact, you put up with whoever enslaves you, whoever **devours** what you have, whoever grabs what you have, whoever exalts himself over you, whoever strikes you in the face. (**2 Corinthians 11:20**)
- Fiery judgments as depicted by the fire that comes out of the mouth of Yehowah's two witnesses to **devour** their enemies.
- And if anyone wants to harm them, fire issues forth from their mouths and **devours** their enemies, and if anyone should want to harm them, in this manner he must be killed. (**Revelation 11:5**)
