[English, eat greedily, consume, get through, demolish, dispose of, gulp down]

- As a malediction Israel would plant much seed, but the locust would devour it.
- A lot of seed you will take out to the field, but little will you gather, because the locust will devour it. (Deuteronomy 28:38)
- The despoiler will not endure, for he will run out of things to devour.
- There is nothing left over for him to devour, that is why his well-being will not endure. (Job 20:21)
- Yehowah God will constitute wicked ones as a fiery furnace when he brings his judgments against them, and will devour them all.
- You will constitute them as a fiery furnace at the appointed time for your attention. Yehowah in his anger will swallow them up, and the fire will devour them. (Psalms 21:9)
- The congregator asked only to devour the food prescribed for him each day, thus leading a simple and balanced life.
- Untruth and the lying word put far away from me. Give me neither poverty nor riches. Let me devour the food prescribed for me. (Proverbs 30:8)
- Isaiah prophesied that a sword, but not a human sword would devour the Assyrians, and this happened when Yehowah God's angel killed 185,000 Assyrians in one night.
- And the Assyrian must fall by the sword, not that of a man, and a sword, not that of earthling man, will devour him. And he must flee because of the sword, and his own young men will come to be for forced labor itself. (Isaiah 31:8)
- Through Jeremiah, Yehowah God foretold that his words would devour them, like pieces of wood in a fire.

- Therefore this is what Yehowah, the God of armies, has said; For the reason that you men are saying this thing, here I am making my words in your mouth a fire, and this people will be pieces of wood, and it will certainly devour them. (Jeremiah 5:14)
- Yehowah told Israel, that if they would not honor his Sabbaths, then he would set a fire ablaze in her gates and devour her.
- But if you will not obey me by sanctifying the Sabbath day and not carrying a load, but there is a coming in with it through the gates of Jerusalem on the Sabbath day, I will also set a fire ablaze in her gates, and it will certainly devour the dwelling towers of Jerusalem and will not be extinguished. (Jeremiah 17:27)
- Through Jeremiah, Yehowah God promised to judge Israel according to her deeds, and set a fire ablaze among her leaders, her forest, and it would devour all the things round about her.
- I will also hold an accounting against you according to the fruitage of your dealings, is the utterance of Yehowah. And I will set a fire ablaze in her forest, and it will certainly devour all the things round about her. (Jeremiah 21:14)
- During the day of vengeance from Yehowah God a sword will devour, and get its fill of their blood.
- And that day belongs to the Sovereign Lord, Yehowah of armies, the day of vengeance for avenging himself upon his adversaries. And the sword will certainly devour and satisfy itself and take its fill of their blood, for the Sovereign Lord, Yehowah of armies, has a sacrifice in the land of the north by the river Euphrates. (Jeremiah 46:10)
- Egypt is told to ready itself for a sword will devour all around her.
- Tell it in Egypt, O men, and publish it in Migdol, and publish it in Noph and in Tahpanhes. Say; Station yourself, making preparation also for yourself, for a sword will certainly devour all around you. (Jeremiah 46:14)
- Jeremiah foretold a fire going forth out of Heshbon and Sihon,
 which would devour the temples of Moab.

- In the shadow of Heshbon those fleeing have stood still without power. For a very fire will certainly go forth out of Heshbon, and a flame from the midst of Sihon, and it will devour the temples of Moab and the crown of the head of the sons of uproar. (Jeremiah 48:45)
- Yehowah God promised to set a fire ablaze on the wall of Damascus, so as to devour the dwelling towers of Ben-hadad.
- And I will set a fire ablaze on the wall of Damascus, and it will certainly devour the dwelling towers of Ben-hadad. (Jeremiah 49:27)
- Yehowah would set a fire ablaze in Presumptuousness, or Babylon, devouring all her cities.
- And Presumptuousness will certainly stumble and fall, and it will have no one to cause it to rise up. And I will set a fire ablaze in its cities, and it must devour all its surroundings. (Jeremiah 50:32)
- Ezekiel promised God would bring upon Israel calamity, by sword, famine and pestilence, devouring them.
- The sword is outside, and the pestilence and the famine are inside. Whoever is in the field, by the sword he will die, and whoever are in the city, famine and pestilence themselves will devour them. (Ezekiel 7:15)
- Through Ezekiel, Yehowah God showed, that any escaping his destruction of Jerusalem, would later be devoured.
- And I have set my face against them. Out of the fire they have gone forth, but the fire itself will devour them. And you people will have to know that I am Yehowah, when I direct my face against them. (Ezekiel 15:7)
- Yehowah God promised to set a fire ablaze in the forest of the south, Israel's leadership, and it would devour every tree, leader, within her.
- And you must say to the forest of the south; Hear the word of Yehowah. This is what the Sovereign Lord Yehowah has said, Here I am setting a fire ablaze against you, and it must devour in

you every still-moist tree and every dry tree. The kindling flame will not be extinguished, and by it all faces must be scorched from the south to the north. (Ezekiel 20:47)

- Ezekiel pronounced that a sword was coming against Ammon that would devour her and glitter with her blood.
- And you, O son of man, prophesy, and you must say; This is what the Sovereign Lord Yehowah has said concerning the sons of Ammon and concerning the reproach from them. And you must say; A sword, a sword drawn for a slaughter, polished to cause it to devour, in order to glitter. (Ezekiel 21:28)
- Ezekiel prophesied against the prophets of Israel who kept devouring treasure and precious things, abusing widows.
- There is a conspiracy of her prophets in the midst of her, like the roaring lion, tearing prey. A soul they actually devour. Treasure and precious things they keep taking. Her widows they have multiplied in the midst of her. (Ezekiel 22:25)
- Yehowah God promised to devour Tyre because of the abundance of her errors and the injustice of her sales goods.
- Owing to the abundance of your errors, because of the injustice of your sales goods, you have profaned your sanctuaries. And I shall bring forth a fire from the midst of you. It is what must devour you. And I shall make you ashes upon the earth before the eyes of all those seeing you. (Ezekiel 28:18)
- Through Ezekiel Yehowah God promise to keep his people from those who would devour them like wild beasts, and then they would dwell in security.
- And they will no longer become something to plunder for the nations, and as regards the wild beast of the earth, it will not devour them, and they will actually dwell in security, with no one to make them tremble. (Ezekiel 34:28)
- Yehowah will bring powerful changes to our earth once he destroys all false religion. Then true religion will no more be a reproach among the nations but it will be lifted up on high and it will dominate earth's landscape and bring in a time of true and lasting

peace. The remnant of the 144,000 will educate all mankind in the ways of peace and bring in a thousand years of peace.

- Therefore humankind you will no more devour, and your nations you will no more bereave of children, is the utterance of the Sovereign Lord Yehowah. (Ezekiel 36:14)
- Daniel saw a vision of a fourth beast that devoured all the earth and trampled it down and crushed it.
- This is what he said; As for the fourth beast, there is a fourth kingdom that will come to be on the earth, that will be different from all the other kingdoms, and it will devour all the earth and will trample it down and crush it. (Daniel 7:23)
- Since Israel and today Christendom have attributed their blessings to their passionate lovers, rather than to God, who alone gives such blessings, Yehowah God will lay desolate her vine and fig tree, removing her fine spiritual produce of the past, and leaving her as a forest, uncultivated for the wild beasts of the field to feed upon.
- And I will lay desolate her vine and her fig tree, of which she has said; They are a gift to me, which my passionate lovers have given to me, and I will set them as a forest, and the wild beast of the field will certainly devour them. (Hosea 2:12)
- Israel dealt treacherously with Yehowah God, and their offspring were not like their God Yehowah, so he would see that their food supplies would not last through the month.
- With Yehowah himself they have dealt treacherously, for it is to strange sons that they have become father. Now a month will devour them with their portions. (Hosea 5:7)
- So the men of Israel have got hot like the furnace to do badness, and they actually devour those set over them as judges. Even their own kings have fallen from Yehowah God's favor, for none of them is calling out to him anymore.
- They get hot, all of them, like the furnace, and they actually devour their judges. Their own kings have all fallen, none among them is calling out to me. (Hosea 7:7)

- Because Israel forgot their maker and built idol temples,
 Yehowah would send fire into their cities and devour their dwelling towers.
- And Israel began forgetting his Maker and building temples, and Judah, for his part, multiplied fortified cities. And I shall certainly send fire into his cities and it must devour the dwelling towers of each one. (Hosea 8:14)
- The bad counsels of Israel would bring a sword whirling through their cities to devour them.
- And a sword will certainly whirl about in his cities and make an end of his bars and devour because of their counsels. (Hosea 11:6)
- Since Israel's leaders were beastlike, Yehowah would come at them like a lion, and devour them there.
- I shall encounter them like a bear that has lost its cubs, and I shall rip apart the enclosure of their heart. And I shall devour them there like a lion, a wild beast of the field itself will tear them to pieces. (Hosea 13:8)
- Yehowah promised to send a fire into the dwelling towers of Benhadad to devour them.
- And I will send a fire onto the house of Hazael, and it must devour the dwelling towers of Ben-hadad. (Amos 1:4)
- Through Amos Yehowah promise to send a fire upon the wall of Gaza, so as to devour her dwelling towers.
- And I will send a fire onto the wall of Gaza, and it must devour her dwelling towers. (Amos 1:7)
- Through Amos Yehowah God promised to send a fire upon the wall of Tyre to devour her dwelling towers.
- And I will send a fire onto the wall of Tyre, and it must devour her dwelling towers. (Amos 1:10)
- Through Amos Yehowah God promised to send a fire upon the wall of Teman to devour her dwelling towers.

- And I will send a fire into Teman, and it must devour the dwelling towers of Bozrah. (Amos 1:12)
- Through Amos Yehowah God promised to send a fire upon the wall of Rabbah to devour her dwelling towers.
- And I will set fire to the wall of Rabbah, and it must devour her dwelling towers, with an alarm signal in the day of battle, with a tempest in the day of storm wind. (Amos 1:14)
- Through Amos Yehowah God promised to send a fire upon the wall of Moab to devour her dwelling towers.
- And I will send a fire into Moab, and it must devour the dwelling towers of Kerioth, and with noise Moab must die, with an alarm signal, with the sound of a horn. (Amos 2:2)
- Through Amos Yehowah God promised to send a fire upon the wall of Judah to devour the dwelling towers of Jerusalem.
- And I will send a fire into Judah, and it must devour the dwelling towers of Jerusalem. (Amos 2:5)
- Yehowah struck his people with scorching and mildew and caterpillars to devour their crops, yet still they would not return to him.
- I struck you people with scorching and mildew. There was a multiplying of your gardens and of your vineyards, but your fig trees and your olive trees the caterpillar would devour, yet you did not come back to me, is the utterance of Yehowah. (Amos 4:9)
- Amos calls for the house of Joseph to search for Yehowah God, or else he will become like a fire and devour without anyone to extinguish it.
- Search for Yehowah, and keep living, that he may not become operative just like fire, O house of Joseph, and it may not actually devour, and Bethel may not be with no one to extinguish it. (Amos 5:6)

- The house of Jacob must become like a fire, and the house of Joseph a flame, and the house of Esau they will set ablaze and devour completely.
- And the house of Jacob must become a fire, and the house of Joseph a flame, and the house of Esau as stubble, and they must set them ablaze and devour them. And there will prove to be no survivor to the house of Esau, for Yehowah himself has spoken it. (Obadiah 1:18)
- Through Nahum, Yehowah God promised to devour the young lions of Nineveh, her upcoming leaders, and no more would her roaring ever be heard again.
- Look! I am against you, is the utterance of Yehowah of armies, and I will burn up her war chariot in the smoke. And a sword will devour your own maned young lions. And I will cut off from the earth your prey, and no more will the voice of your messengers be heard. (Nahum 2:13)
- Nahum showed that the defenders of Nineveh would become like women, not defending her gates, allowing a fire to enter and to devour her.
- Look! Your people are women in the midst of you. To your enemies the gates of your land must without fail be opened. Fire will certainly devour your bars. (Nahum 3:13)
- Nahum calls for the defenders of Nineveh to become many like the locust for the fire of Yehowah God's anger will devour among them.
- Even there fire will devour you. A sword will cut you off. It will devour you like the locust species. Make yourself heavy in numbers like the locust species, make yourself heavy in numbers like the locust. (Nahum 3:15)
- Then Yehowah God himself will defend his people, and they will actually devour and subdue their enemies with slingstones. And they will certainly drink and become boisterous, as though there were wine, and they will actually become filled like the bowl by the altar, like the corners of the altar.
- Yehowah of armies himself will defend them, and they will actually devour and subdue the slingstones. And they will

certainly drink, be boisterous, as if there were wine, and they will actually become filled like the bowl, like the corners of the altar. (Zechariah 9:15)

- Zechariah calls for Lebanon to open her doors that a fire may devour among her tall cedars.
- Open up your doors, O Lebanon, that a fire may devour among your cedars. (Zechariah 11:1)
- Yehowah said he would stop shepherding his people, letting each one of them devour their companions.
- At length I said; I shall not keep shepherding you. The one that is dying, let her die. And the one that is being effaced, let her be effaced. And as for the ones left remaining, let them devour, each one the flesh of her companion. (Zechariah 11:9)
- Zechariah showed that in that day Yehowah God would make the sheiks off Judah like a firepot among rows of grain, and they would devour on the right and on the left.
- In that day I shall make the sheiks of Judah like a firepot among trees and like a fiery torch in a row of newly cut grain, and they must devour on the right hand and on the left all the peoples round about, and Jerusalem must yet be inhabited in her own place, in Jerusalem. (Zechariah 12:6)
- Yehowah's Day is coming like a burning furnace that will devour all the wicked ones who are like stubble before a flame.
- For, look! The day is coming that is burning like the furnace, and all the presumptuous ones and all those doing wickedness must become as stubble. And the day that is coming will certainly devour them, Yehowah of armies has said, so that it will not leave to them either root or bough. (Malachi 4:1)
- Jesus condemned the Pharisees for devouring the houses of the widows and for making long prayers.
- And who devour the houses of the widows and for a pretext make long prayers. These will receive a heavier judgment. (Luke 20:47)

- Peter warns spirit anointed Christians to be watchful, for their adversary Satan the Devil walks about throughout the earth like a roaring lion seeking to devour them.
- Keep your senses, be watchful. Your adversary, the Devil, walks about like a roaring lion, seeking to devour someone. (1 Peter 5:8)
- The dragon, Satan the Devil is intent upon trying to devour the Messianic child of Revelation Chapter 12 at his birth.
- And its tail drags a third of the stars of heaven, and it hurled them down to the earth. And the dragon kept standing before the woman who was about to give birth, that, when she did give birth, it might devour her child. (Revelation 12:4)
