## ~DIFFICULT (140)

[English, hard, tricky, not easy, easier said than done, complicated, thorny, complex, intricate, Opposite of, easy]

- Moses told Israel that the commandment that he was commanding them today was not to difficult for them to perform.
- For this commandment that I am commanding you today is not too difficult for you, nor is it far away. (Deuteronomy 30:11)
- Israel hid their food supplies in underground storage places difficult to approach, for fear of Midian.
- And the hand of Midian came to prevail over Israel. Due to Midian the sons of Israel made for themselves the underground store places that were in the mountains, and the caves and the places difficult to approach. (Judges 6:2)
- David hid in places difficult to approach, when hiding from wicked king Saul.
- And David took up dwelling in the wilderness in places difficult to approach, and he kept dwelling in the mountainous region in the wilderness of Ziph. And Saul kept looking for him always, and God did not give him into his hand. (1 Samuel 23:14)
- Later the men of Ziph went up to Saul at Gibeah, saying; Is not David concealing himself close by us in the places difficult to approach at Horesh, on the hill of Hachilah, which is to the right side of Jeshimon? (1 Samuel 23:19)
- Then David made his way up from there and took up dwelling in the places difficult to approach at En-gedi. (1 Samuel 23:29)
- Accordingly David swore to Saul, after which Saul went to his home. As for David and his men, they went up to the place difficult to approach. (1 Samuel 24:22)
- Amnon felt sick at heart over his love for his sister Tamar, and it was difficult in his eyes to do anything to her.
- And it was so distressing to Amnon that he felt sick on account of

Tamar his sister, because she was a virgin, and it was difficult in the eyes of Amnon to do anything at all to her. (2 Samuel 13:2)

- Solomon asked Yehowah God for wisdom to judge properly his difficult people.
- And you must give to your servant an obedient heart to judge your people, to discern between good and bad, for who is able to judge this difficult people of yours? (1 Kings 3:9)
- Elijah showed Elisha, that he had asked for a difficult thing.
- At that he said; You have asked a difficult thing. If you see me when taken from you, it will happen to you that way, but if you do not, it will not happen. (2 Kings 2:10)
- David took up dwelling in Jebus a city difficult to approach militarily.
- And David took up dwelling in the place difficult to approach.
  That is why they called it the City of David. (1 Chronicles 11:7)
- Some Gadites joined themselves to David at the place difficult to approach, also the sons of Benjamin.
- And there were some of the Gadites that separated themselves to David's side at the place difficult to approach in the wilderness, valiant, mighty men, army men for the war, keeping the large shield and the lance ready, whose faces were the faces of lions, and they were like the gazelles upon the mountains for speed. (1 Chronicles 12:8)
- And some of the sons of Benjamin and Judah proceeded to come clear to the place difficult to approach, to David. (1 Chronicles 12:16)
- He is one who is walking in continual righteousness and speaking what is upright, who is rejecting the unjust gain from frauds, he will reside upon the heights in places difficult to approach.
- He is the one that will reside on the heights themselves, his secure height will be craggy places difficult to approach. His own bread will certainly be given him, his water supply will be unfailing. (Isaiah 33:16)

- The false wise men of Babylon found the request of Nebuchadnezzar difficult, for no king had ever asked such a thing before that.
- But the thing that the king himself is asking is difficult, and nobody else exists who can show it before the king except the gods, whose own dwelling does not exist with flesh at all. (Daniel 2:11)
- Yehowah God showed Zechariah, that nothing is too difficult for him to accomplish.
- This is what Yehowah of armies has said; Although it should seem too difficult in the eyes of the remaining ones of this people in those days, should it seem too difficult also in my eyes? Is the utterance of Yehowah of armies. (Zechariah 8:6)
- Jesus showed, that it would be a difficult thing for a rich man to get into heaven. Harder than a camel going through the eye of a needle.
- But Jesus said to his disciples; Truly I say to you that it will be a difficult thing for a rich man to get into the kingdom of the heavens. (Matthew 19:23)
- After looking around Jesus said to his disciples; How difficult a thing it will be for those with money to enter into the kingdom of God! (Mark 10:23)
- But the disciples gave way to surprise at his words. In response Jesus again said to them; Children, how difficult a thing it is to enter into the kingdom of God! (Mark 10:24)
- Jesus looked at him and said; How difficult a thing it will be for those having money to make their way into the kingdom of God! (Luke 18:24)
