- Having a diligent hand will provide well for one.
- The one working with a slack hand will be of little means, but the hand of the diligent one is what will make one rich. (Proverbs 10:4)
- The hand of the diligent ones is the one that will rule, but the slack hand will come to be for forced labor. (Proverbs 12:24)
- Slackness will not start up ones game animals, but the diligent one is a man's precious wealth. (Proverbs 12:27)
- The lazy one is desirous, but the diligent one is made fat.
- The lazy one is showing himself desirous, but his soul has nothing. However, the very soul of the diligent ones will be made fat. (Proverbs 13:4)
- The diligent one plans for a future day to his own advantage
- The plans of the diligent one surely make for advantage, but everyone that is hasty surely heads for want. (Proverbs 21:5)
- Jesus parents returned to Jerusalem and there made a diligent search for the young child Jesus.
- But, not finding him, they returned to Jerusalem, making a diligent search for him. (Luke 2:45)
- When an angel released Peter from prison in the middle of the night Herod made a diligent search for him and then commanded for the guards to be punished.
