## ~DIMNAH (29) (Dim'nah)

- Evidently the same as Rimmon;
- And from there it passed over eastward toward the sunrise to Gath-hepher, to Eth-kazin, and went out to Rimmon and was marked out to Neah. (Joshua 19:13)
- And Rimmono
- To the sons of Merari that were left over they gave from the tribe of Zebulun Rimmono with its pasture grounds, Tabor with its pasture grounds. (1 Chronicles 6:77)
- A city on the East border of Zebulun's territory given to the Merarite Levites.
- And the families of the sons of Merari, the Levites who were left over, had out of the tribe of Zebulun Jokneam and its pasture ground, Kartah and its pasture ground. (Joshua 21:34)
- Dimnah and its pasture ground, Nahalal and its pasture ground, four cities. (Joshua 21:35)
- Dimnah is commonly identified with modern Rummana, Rimmon, about 10 kilometers (6 miles) North of Nazareth.
