

~DISCERNED (30)

[English, distinguished, told the difference, separated, discriminated, differentiated, determined, detected, recognized]

- Daniel **discerned** by study that the seventy years of desolation of Jerusalem had been completed.
- In the first year of his reigning I myself, Daniel, **discerned** by the books the number of the years concerning which the word of Yehowah had occurred to Jeremiah the prophet, for fulfilling the devastations of Jerusalem, namely, seventy years. (**Daniel 9:2**)
- Jesus could **discern** what others were thinking and reasoning in their hearts.
- But Jesus, having **discerned** immediately by his spirit that they were reasoning that way in themselves, said to them; Why are you reasoning these things in your hearts? (**Mark 2:8**)
- Jesus told the people of Jerusalem that they had missed out on peace from Yehowah because they failed to **discern** what was right before their eyes.
- Saying: If you, even you, had **discerned** in this day the things having to do with peace, but now they have been hid from your eyes. (**Luke 19:42**)
